Heavy Duty Brush Cutter

FEATURE: Grease Filled Drive

Direct Drive

REASON:

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Much more reliable than oil, especially in the case of losing a lower seal. In this case the oil
will run out resulting in a seized bearing. The grease being thicker will not run out so easy
and is more visible if it does come out

FEATURE: 3 Blades

- REASON: 1)
- 1) More blades give a cleaner cut and allows for a larger cutting capacity than a 2 blade configuration. Many entry and mid-level brush cutters use 2 blades

FEATURE: Raised Back

REASON: 1) This allows the cut debris to come out consistently. Decks that go all the way to the ground on the rear will drag debris and be more prone to plugging up and bogging out. It also makes operation smoother by not snagging on all the little stumps, and distributes the cut product more evenly making a visibly nicer finished look

FEATURE: 1/4" Thick Deck

REASON: 1) Many comparable units to this model use a 3/16" deck

FEATURE: Front Chain Curtain

REASON: 1) Safer operation by cutting down the amount of flying debris

1) Many brush cutters in this class use either a gearbox

warranty against spindle breakage
